



Procedure Information Sheet

Introduction

Chemical skin peeling is one of the peeling treatments which applies natural Glycolic Acid gradually, and it helps patient remove damaged outer skin, stimulate cell growth and improve skin tone and texture.

Indication

- Acnes
- Smooth acne scars
- Improve skin tone
- Reduce fine wrinkles lines
- Improve enlarged pores
- Restore skin texture

Before the Operation / Procedure

1. There maybe some minor discomfort such as slight tingling, itchiness.
2. To achieve maximum results, several treatments are required.
3. There is no guarantee in the degree of the improvement of this therapy, results may vary.
4. Taking photographs is required before and after treatment.

After the Operation / Procedure

1. Irritation or redness may occur on treated area, and last for about 1-7 days.
2. Transient wound with scab formation may develop after treatment, scab will peel off within a week.
3. Flaking is similar to that of minor sunburn. Use of moisturizer will mask the appearance of flaking.
4. Hypopigmentation and hypopigmentation may last 1-3 months or longer after treatment, depends on your skin type.
